Wing Kei Highland Park Roof Topping Ceremony

On the afternoon of May 15, 2025, Wing Kei celebrated a memorable milestone with the roof topping ceremony of Wing Kei Village Phase I. Guests were invited to sign their names on the final steel beam, marking their presence in this momentous occasion. Looking ahead, Wing Kei Village Phase I will be named Wing Kei Highland Park Care Centre and is expected to open in Fall 2026. This new facility will offer 180+ continuing care beds, including a specialized dementia unit and a hospice to support our community with compassion and dignity.
