

Family update #105

Dear family and friends,

It is heartening to see the decrease of new COVID cases in Alberta in the last couple of weeks and the possibility it brings of the province gradually re-opening, especially with the beautiful Alberta summer around the corner. We are very grateful that our centres have remained free of COVID since early April. A sincere thanks to all residents, family members, and staff for diligently following all public health protocols and receiving the vaccination. 98% of Wing Kei residents and 97% of our care staff have been immunized. We strongly believe that taking the vaccine will protect every one of us.

Phased Approach for Safe Visitation

The Family Town Hall was held on June 2, 2021, and we once again experienced immense support from family members. We discussed how we are progressing with the phased approach for safe visitation. Family members also shared their appreciation for the care their beloved family receive at Wing Kei. This is so encouraging and heartwarming for us; and we have shared your sentiments with the whole team.

We are pleased to let you know that phase one of the safe visitation plan, which was to increase the number of designated family/support persons from two to four people, has been fully implemented. We are now ready to implement phase 2 which is outdoor visits (in the garden or in a designated area) and taking your loved one out for a stroll in the neighborhood. Please note the following guidelines for outdoor visits:
