Dear family and friends,

### COVID Update

We are sorry to inform you that a resident who lives on the fourth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights tested positive for COVID-19.

**An outbreak has been declared for the fourth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights, as directed by Alberta Health Services Communicable Disease Control. In person visits on the fourth floor are not permitted with immediate effect and until further notice. We encourage essential visits only for other floors.**

The resident who tested positive has been in quarantine since last weekend when their family member tested positive for the virus. The resident began experiencing mild symptoms on Wednesday, was placed in isolation, and has since tested positive. Our physician attended to the resident today and has no concerns. We have been monitoring the individual, and all residents, very closely. We are grateful that no other residents are experiencing any symptoms of COVID and that both the resident and their family member are doing well.

We are being diligent in following preventative measures. Initial rapid test results have been conducted and the results are negative for all residents and staff on the fourth floor. PCR (polymerase chain reaction) testing will be arranged as an additional precautionary measure. We are glad that most residents received the third dose of the COVID vaccine last week, further protecting them from the virus.

As you will have heard from all news sources, COVID, and the Delta variant in particular, is vicious. It is travelling at incredible speed through people who are unvaccinated. While vaccinated individuals can still become infected, the symptoms of those who have been vaccinated will experience are much less severe. Please follow all health protocols closely and be extra cautious in your daily activities at home, at work, and in the community.

Please keep Wing Kei in your prayers.
