## **COVID Update**

A member of our staff who works on the second floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights tested positive for COVID today. The individual is asymptomatic. A resident on the same unit, who was experiencing mild symptoms of the virus, also tested positive. As a precautionary measure, all residents on the second floor received rapid testing. Five residents tested positive. Swabs have since been sent for PCR testing and results are pending. As a temporary measure and to minimize risk of transmission, we ask families with loved ones on the second floor of Crescent Heights to come for essential visits only.
