### **COVID Update**

We are grateful that all our residents are doing well. Many of the affected residents have recovered and are now out of isolation. We will continue to follow up on their well-being with continuous assessment. At present we have 19 residents on the second floor and 8 residents on the fifth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights in isolation per MOH COVID isolation orders.

#### **Visitation**

Just a reminder that only essential visits are allowed on the second floor and fifth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights. We also recommend that visitation be limited to essential visits on the remaining floors, as a precautionary measure. On Good Friday, April 15, reception at both locations are closed. Visitation hours are from 9 am to 4 pm.

#### **University of Alberta Post COVID Study**

The University of Alberta is currently carrying out a provincial Post COVID Study with support from AHS and Alberta Health. The study will focus on a range of mental health, quality of life, and physical impacts related to accessing testing, receiving care, and the long-term sequelae of those who tested positive.
