### **COVID-19 Update**

### **Greenview Supportive Living Main Floor**

As of today, six residents on the unit have tested positive. The residents who tested positive are experiencing mild symptoms and recovering well. One resident is currently out of isolation. A seventh resident is began experiencing mild symptoms this morning. We administered a PCR test and are awaiting the results.

### **Greenview Supportive Living Third Floor**

The resident who tested positive on June 22 is recovering well and has no more symptoms. Rapid tests results of all other residents on the unit are negative.

Greenview Supportive Living is still on outbreak; visitation is limited to essential visitors only.

#### Wing Kei Crescent Heights Third Floor

One resident who tested positive remains in isolation. All residents are doing well. **The third floor of Crescent Heights is still on outbreak; visitation is limited to essential visitors only.** 

The outbreaks reinforce that COVID continues to be present in the community. Please do all you can to remain safe and minimize risk of spread.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Booster Dose

Ten eligible residents at Greenview Long Term Care received their 2<sup>nd</sup> booster dose of the COVID vaccine yesterday. We continue to arrange for booster doses as residents become eligible to receive them.

#### Step 3 of easing public health measures

A reminder that although CMOH Orders in continuing care will be rescinded on June 30, protective measures will remain in place in continuing care centres, through Alberta Health Services' (AHS) standards and policies, to protect residents:

- PCR testing as appropriate
- Isolating symptomatic residents
- Outbreak procedures
- Use of PPE
- Reporting illnesses to AHS
- Continuous masking for staff and visitors

Please note that we are maintaining entry screening of visitors at all Wing Kei facilities until further notice. We are unsure about the possibility of another major wave of the virus and will continually reassess protocols, for everyone's safety. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
