### **Respiratory Infection Outbreak**

The respiratory infection outbreak on the third floor of Greenview Supportive Living was lifted on September 7. We are grateful that all residents on the unit are doing well. Thanks to families and visitors for your support and deferred visit during the outbreak.

As the flu season is approaching, flu shots for all residents have been arranged and will be given in October. We strongly encourage family members to get the flu shot as well when it is available in the community.

#### **Resident/Family Survey on visitation protocols**

We have conducted another survey on visitation protocols for the residents at the 3 sites and family members in September. Below are the results:

Phase 2 of the renovation project is nearing completion. With the removal of the hoarding wall, you may now see a modern, bright and spacious reception and lobby area as you enter the facility. A multi-functional Board Room for various purposes is also available.
