Outbreaks Update

COVID outbreak on Greenview Supportive Living 3F

We are grateful that the nine affected residents on the third floor of Greenview Supportive Living have been recovering well. The outbreak should be lifted on September 1 if no more residents are affected. Sincere thanks for families' and residents' support and cooperation.

Influenza outbreak on Greenview Supportive Living 2F

Two residents on the second floor of Greenview Supportive Living have confirmed influenza symptoms. Currently the unit is on Influenza Outbreak. We are grateful that the symptoms of the affected residents are mild and they are recovering well. Tentatively the flu outbreak will be lifted on September 1 if there are no further confirmed cases.

We will monitor the conditions very closely. To prevent the spread of the viruses, families and visitors are reminded to defer your visits if you are feeling unwell and always practise good hand hygiene. Thank you very much for your cooperation.
