### COVID Update

We are thankful that the outbreak on the first floor of Greenview Long Term Care was lifted on October 2.

Currently, two residents on the **fourth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights** have tested positive. Their symptoms are mild and they are doing well. The unit is on outbreak. We are monitoring the condition very closely.

Again, we request that **only essential visitors come to the unit**, including meal time assistants who provide feeding support during meals and emotional support for the residents. Other fourth floor visitors are encouraged to communicate with the unit nurse first prior to visitation.

### COVID and Flu vaccination

The number of COVID and confirmed Influenza cases in the community and continuing care facilities has been increasing. To protect our residents from these viruses, we have arranged for them to receive both vaccines at the same time this year. Eligible Greenview Supportive Living residents have received the vaccines today, October 10. Greenview Long Term Care residents will receive on October 11, and Crescent Heights residents on October 16.

The [Moderna SpikeVax XBB.1.5 vaccine](#) will be given. It will also be available to Albertans older than 6 months starting October 16. Influenza Immunization will also be provided for the general public starting on the same day. Families and visitors are encouraged to get the vaccines to protect your health.

### Renovation of Resident Rooms at Wing Kei Crescent Heights

We are happy to share that wall painting of all resident rooms completed in mid September. Replacement of flooring in the common area and bathrooms on the units has completed. A few resident rooms were also done to assess the process and timing. Alberta Health Services personnel who came for the inspection earlier this month were satisfied with the process of the renovation and its progress, and approved the project to continue. The floor replacement work will resume in the third week of November. We would like to thank all residents and families for your cooperation and support during the renovation project.
