Dear family and friends,

Influenza-Like Illness Outbreak

As of today, one resident is still on isolation on the second floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights. All other residents are doing well.

On the fifth floor of Wing Kei Crescent Heights, most of the affected residents have recovered. Seven residents are currently on isolation.

As advised by the AHS Communicable Disease Control:

- visitors are encouraged to postpone visitation if possible;
- visitors to limit visit to one resident only and exit the facility immediately after the visit.

We encourage visitation by essential visitors only at this time who provide support during meal times (feeding) and emotional support for the residents on the affected units.

Please also note that **continuous masking on the units is mandatory**. Continuous masking in the common area of the facilities is encouraged. Thank you very much for your support and cooperation.
